Coming from the East:

From the Long Island Expressway: Exit at 49N (Route 110 north) and proceed north on Route 110 for about 5 miles. You will pass the Walt Whitman Mall on your right hand side. Make a left onto Jericho Turnpike and proceed west on Jericho for about 1/2 mile. Make a left at the second light onto West Hills Road, and then a right into the school. Check in with the security guard and park in the lot directly in front of the school. The main office entrance is two doors to the right of the overhang entrance.

Coming from the West:

From the Long Island Expressway: Exit at 49N (Route 110 north) and proceed north on Route 110 for about 5 miles. You will pass the Walt Whitman Mall on your right hand side. Make a left onto Jericho Turnpike and proceed west on Jericho for about 1/2 mile. Make a left at the second light onto West Hills Road, and then a right into the school.
